

Growth curves are an important tool your child's healthcare providers use to track, predict, and evaluate growth over time. Achondroplasia-specific growth curves are essential in the care of growing infants and children with achondroplasia and can empower caregivers to ensure their healthcare providers have access to accurate and relevant information. These growth curves were created using data points\* from over 1,300 individuals with achondroplasia. Be sure to bring these growth curves to your next doctor's appointment to assess growth over time and facilitate healthcare discussions.

\*Achondroplasia Natural History Study (CLARITY) is an 18-year multicenter study of 1,374 subjects with over 37,000 data points which are the basis of these Growth Curves specific to those living with achondroplasia. One of the CLARITY objectives was to develop growth curves (length/ height, weight, head circumference, weight-for-height) and corresponding reference tables of mean and standard deviations at 1-month increments from birth through 18 years for clinical use and research for achondroplasia patients.

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
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Length for Age Males: Birth to 36 Months



Height for Age Males: 2 to 18 Years





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Length for Age Females: Birth to 36 Months



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


Height for Age Females: 2 to 18 Years



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


Age (years)

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

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

Females: 2 to 18 Years



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

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


Weight for Height Males: 110 cm to 140 cm



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


Weight for Height Females: 110 cm to 130 cm
